Bus Driver Letter

Thank you for bringing your group safely to the Bay Area Discovery Museum. Here are some helpful tips to make drop-off and pick-up as smooth as possible.

Directions to BADM

Some GPS programs have problems with directions when using our address. For best results, enter “**Bay Area Discovery Museum**” into your program.

- From San Francisco and the South Bay: Take 101 across the Golden Gate Bridge and take the Alexander Avenue exit just after the Vista Point. Follow signs to Fort Baker and the Bay Area Discovery Museum.
- From the East Bay: Take 580 west across the Richmond/San Rafael Bridge. Follow the signs to 101 south, then follow the directions from the North Bay.
- From the North Bay: Take 101 South. After the Waldo Tunnel and just before the Golden Gate Bridge, take the Alexander Avenue exit and follow signs to Fort Baker and the Bay Area Discovery Museum.

Drop-off

Please pull to the end of the bus turnaround before off-loading passengers, so that other buses can pull in as well. BADM staff will greet you to help unload passengers and lunches, and confirm your departure time.

Parking

Large-vehicle parking is located at the waterfront. You are welcome to use the facilities at BADM while waiting for your group. The closest places to get food/coffee are at the Café at BADM and the Store at Cavallo Point.

Departure

Please pull into the turnaround no earlier than 15 minutes before your departure time, to avoid blocking other buses. Drive to the end of the turnaround to wait for the group to board.
