What is the Bay Area Discovery Museum? The Bay Area Discovery Museum is a nonprofit children's museum with a mission to transform research into early learning experiences that inspire creative problem solving. Museum programming focuses on creativity development and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) education. What will my child do at the museum? Upon arrival, School Programs staff greets the group and guides your child's class into the museum. During some field trips, children and adults participate in STEM-focused programs led by School Programs staff. The field trip also includes free exploration of the museum's exhibits and programming.
How should my child dress for a field trip to the museum? On the day of the field trip, please make sure your child wears sturdy shoes and dresses in layers that can get messy. The weather in Sausalito changes constantly, and museum activities can be messy – think water, mud, and paint.
How can you get involved? In order to participate in this experience, we need your support as chaperones so that your class can safely explore the museum. BADM requires a minimum supervisory ratio of one adult for every five students. Please let your child's teacher know if you can volunteer for this field trip.
