

Ways to Join

Provide proof of eligibility and payment through one of the following methods.

Online: Email proof of eligibility to membership@badm.org and we will provide you with access to purchase online and reserve member tickets.

By Mail: Send in your proof of eligibility, the attached form, and a \$40 check made out to Bay Area Discovery Museum. Once you receive confirmation of membership you will be able to reserve free member tickets online.

In Person: Bring proof of legibility to sign up for membership and reserve tickets for the next available timeslot.
